

**REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS OF THE BENEFITS OF LAW 168
PARTIAL EXEMPTION FROM TAXES TO VEHICLES**

1. TO THE DOMINICANS, COME TO SET YOUR RESIDENCE AGAIN AFTER HAVING RESIDE FOR THE EXTERIOR TWO (2) YEARS AT LEAST, AND FOR THE FOREIGNERS, COME TO SET YOUR RESIDENCE IN OUR COUNTRY.

• NOTE: Not having stayed in the country over a period of more than six (6) months accumulated during the two (2) years.

If you are STUDENT, present the title, certificate or diploma of the studies you were doing, in original and a copy.

The General Directorate of Customs reserves the right to carry out all site investigations in order to check it out.

• NOTE: Applicants are advised not to comply with this requirement set out in law 168, proceed with the seizure of the vehicle.

2. DEMONSTRATE THE PROPERTY OF THE IMPORTED VEHICLE (ORIGINAL TITLE OF PROPERTY AND COPY). THE TIME YOU MUST HAVE THE VEHICLE IN POSSESSION OF THE OWNER SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN ONE (1) YEAR, AS PROVIDED BY LAW 168.

3. SUBMIT THE ORIGINAL RESIDENCE, OR PASSPORT, IF YOU ARE A CITIZEN, OR CERTIFICATION OF NATURALIZATION, WITH A COPY OF THE DOCUMENT CORRESPONDING.

4. IF THE CONTRIBUTOR IS A FOREIGNER, SUBMIT RESIDENCY DOMINICAN REPUBLIC.

5. SUBMITTING THE CURRENT PASSPORT (S) SHOULD HAVE A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPEDITION.

6. COPY OF ALL PAGES OF THE PASSPORTS.

7. PRESENT KNOWLEDGE OF BILL OF LADING ON BEHALF OF THE VEHICLE OWNER IMPORTED, MACHINED AND SEALED BY THE COLLECTURE AND 3 COPIES.

8. PRESENT THE LAST REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE IF THE TITLE HAS LESS THAN ONE (1) YEAR OF ISSUANCE.

9. OBTAIN AND SUBMIT A RECEIPT OF ACCOUNTING SEALED AND SIGNED BY A VALUE OF RD \$ 300.00 (THREE HUNDRED PESOS), THE RECEIPT CORRESPONDING TO THE RIGHT APPLICATION FOR THE PROCESSING OF LAWS.

10. SUBMITTING TAX SETTLEMENT OF THE COLLECTURE VEHICLE (PRINTER), SEALED BY THE SAME AND CLEAR A COPY.

11. SUBMIT A LETTER OF MARRIAGE IF MARRIED (A) OR ORIGINAL DIVORCE, UPDATED TO THE (RECENT) DATE.
